ORDINANCE NO. 1049

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A BOAT RAMP GRANT FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley, Ohio has received funding from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources NatureWorks Program for the building of a boat ramp; and


WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley, Ohio has committed Village funding for one-fourth (1/4) of the cost of this project;

NOW BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION 1. The Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Ripley, Ohio shall create an account designated as the Boat Ramp Grant fund.



That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of said Village and its inhabitants, and more particularly to maintain the orderly affairs of government. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
