

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY

ORDINANCE NO. 1060

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND CAPITAL OUTLAY TO THE GENERAL FUND POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the General Fund Police Department has insufficient funds to fully and properly operate the Police Department until December 31, 1998; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary, in order to provide for the orderly affairs of government and to provide for the safety and security of the Citizens of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, to have a fully funded Police Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1: Twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) be transferred from the General Fund Capital Outlay fund to the Police Department Wages and Benefits fund, and that six thousand (\$6,000) be transferred from the General Fund Capital Outlay fund to the Police Department Maintenance and Supplies fund.


SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley and to insure the orderly affairs of government of this municipality and shall be effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
