ORDINANCE NO. 1064

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 873 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO TO PROVIDE FOR A NEW ANNUAL FEE FOR TAXI CAB LICENSES IN THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 873 adopted by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Ohio on January 2, 1989, the annual license fee for each taxi cab licensed in the Village of Ripley was set at \$150.00 per taxi cab license, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Ripley believes that it is in the best interests of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley, especially the senior citizens thereof, that taxi cab companies be encouraged to operate within the Village of Ripley, by reason of which the annual license fee for taxi cabs should be reduced,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, two thirds or more of all members thereof concurring as follows, that:

SECTION 1. The annual license fee for each taxi cab licensed in the Village of Ripley shall be \$50.00 per taxi cab license, effective January 1, 1999.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 873 is hereby repealed as being in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance but that all other parts or sections of said Ordinance No. 873 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley, Ohio and more particularly for the reason that it is in the best interests of the citizens of said community, especially senior citizens, that taxi cab companies be encouraged to operate in the Village of Ripley and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
