

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1079

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND JOURNALIZING A FOUR WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF ELIZABETH STREET AND THE PARKING LOT OF THE COMMUNITY BUILDING AND RIPLEY METALWORKS FACTORY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley has erected its Community Building at the rear of the Ripley MetalWorks factory building; and

WHEREAS, additional traffic caused by the location of the Community Building and the operation of the Ripley MetalWorks factory has created a substantial risk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:


SECTION 1. A four (4) way stop designation shall be in effect where the north end of Elizabeth Street intersects with the parking lot of the Ripley Community Building and the drive along the Ripley MetalWorks factory building.

SECTION 2. Four (4) way stop signs and stop bars shall be erected at this location.


SECTION 3. Failure to stop and yield the right of way at this location shall be considered a minor misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$50.00.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
