

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1090

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley, Ohio has entered into an agreement with the Ohio Emergency Management Agency (OEMA) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the purpose of Hazard Mitigation, and


WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley, Ohio has received funding from OEMA and FEMA for the purchase of and removal of property from the flood plain area, in the amount of \$47,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:


SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated into the treasury of the Village of Ripley, Ohio, the \$47,000 in funds received from OEMA and FEMA. That these funds are appropriated as per directions of the Auditor of the State of Ohio as defined by their rules and regulations concerning emergency appropriations.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley and more particularly to insure the orderly affairs of government of this municipality and to provide for the usual daily operation of this municipality, therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
