ORDINANCE NO. 1103

AN ORDINANCE SETTING REVISED RATES AND CHARGES  
FOR WATER AND SEWER TAPS FOR THE CUSTOMERS OF  
THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENTS

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley provides water and sewer service to residents and to some non-residents of the Village of Ripley; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley charges a tap fee for new connections to the water and sewer system; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed the current fees being charged for water and sewer taps, it is the opinion of the Council of the Village of Ripley that such fees need to be increased to cover the cost of such connections as well as to provide for the future growth of the Village and increased demand on the water and sewer systems,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring, that::

SECTION 1. Effective July 12, 2001, the charge for new water taps to connect to the Village of Ripley Water System shall be as follows:


<u>Water Line</u>	<u>In Town</u>	<u>Out of Town</u>
3/4 inch	\$ 600.00	\$ 800.00
1 inch	\$ 700.00	\$ 900.00
1-1/2 inch	\$ 800.00	\$1,000.00
2 inch	\$ 900.00	\$1,100.00
3 inch	\$1,000.00	\$1,200.00

SECTION 2. Effective July 12, 2001, the charge for new sewer taps to connect to the Village of Ripley Sewer System shall be as follows:


<u>In Town</u>	<u>Out of Town</u>
\$1,000.00	\$1,500.00

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
