

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 1194

AN ORDINANCE AWARING A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION
WITH THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY ODNR PUBLIC RESTROOM PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley has heretofore twice advertised for sealed bids for the Village of Ripley ODNR Public Restroom Project; and

WHEREAS, no bids have been submitted in response to either advertisement for bid; and

WHEREAS, it appearing to Council that the funds allocated for said project will be lost unless said project is constructed prior to December 31, 2007; and

WHEREAS, there is insufficient time remaining to advertise for sealed bids yet again and construct said project by December 31, 2007; and

WHEREAS Wayne Monnette dba Monnette Masonry has offered to construct said project for the Village of Ripley at a cost of \$48,700.00;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION 1. The offer of Wayne Monnette, dba Monnette Masonry to construct said project at a cost of \$48,700.00 is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. The Village Administrator is directed to enter into a contract on behalf of the Village of Ripley with the said Wayne Monnette, dba Monnette Masonry for said project in such amount in accordance with the specifications on file in the Office of said Village Administrator.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley and more particularly for the reason that it is necessary to award a contract for the project described herein in order that the funds allocated to said project not be lost and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
