

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1199

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE REGIONAL INCOME TAX AGENCY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE INCOME TAX LAWS OF THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY AND FOR THE COLLECTION OF SAID TAXES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley desires to contract with an outside agency to administer the income tax laws of Ripley and to act as its agent in the collection of said taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley is in receipt of a proposal from the Regional Income Tax Agency for the administration of these services; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Ripley desires to authorize the Mayor and the Fiscal Officer to enter into an agreement with the Regional Income Tax Agency;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer of the Village of Ripley are hereby directed and authorized to enter into an agreement with the Regional Income Tax Agency to have said agency act as this Village's agent in administering the income tax laws of the Village of Ripley, and to collect said income taxes.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall supercede all previously adopted Ordinances in direct conflict herewith.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Ripley, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the Village of Ripley to enter into an agreement with the Regional Income Tax Agency to administer the income tax laws of the Village of Ripley and to act as its agent in the collection of said taxes and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
