

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1210

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTION OF
CHERRY STREET AND THIRD STREET AS A 4-WAY STOP
IN THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley owns and operates a public park in vicinity of Cherry Street between Second Alley and Fourth Street in the Village of Ripley; and

WHEREAS, the movement of motor vehicles upon the public street in the vicinity of said park poses a risk of injury to children playing in said park (e.g., a child could dart across the street and into moving traffic);

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Ripley believes that the movement of traffic in the vicinity of said park should be regulated,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION 1. The intersection of the public streets known as Cherry Street and Third Street in the Village of Ripley is hereby designated as a four-way stop and all vehicles approaching said intersection shall be require to stop at said intersection before proceeding safely through said intersection.

SECTION 2. The Village of Ripley Street Department shall mark the intersection of Cherry Street and Third Street with appropriate stop signs on Cherry Street and Third Street.

SECTION 3. Whoever violates Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be fined as is provided in the Ohio Basic Code of Ordinances adopted by the Village of Ripley.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the public health, safety and welfare and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
