

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1262

AN ORDINANCE RESTRUCTURING THE FUNDS THAT PAY THE
VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, a majority or more of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION 1. The funds for the salary and benefits for the Village Administrator shall be paid as follows:

- (A) From the Electric fund for 4 months;
- (B) From the Sewer fund for 4 months;
- (C) From the Water fund for 3 months;
- (D) From the Trash fund for 1 month.

SECTION 2. The funds for the salary and benefits for the Fiscal Officer shall be paid as follows:

- (A) From the Electric fund for 4 months;
- (B) From the Sewer fund for 4 months;
- (C) From the Water fund for 3 months;
- (D) From the Trash fund for 1 month.

SECTION 3. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same hereby repealed as to the extent that they are inconsistent.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley and more particularly for the for orderly affairs of government and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
