ORDINANCE NO. 1787

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF UTE 3165, 47' FOR
THE RIPLEY UTILITIES DEPARTMENT WITHOUT
ADVERTISING AND BIDDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the present truck as used by the Ripley Electric Department is no longer suitable for safe, reliable and efficient use by said department in the ordinary course of business of the Ripley Utilities Department; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the ordinary course of business of the Ripley Utilities Department and the Ripley Electric Department to have available a safe, reliable and efficient truck; and

WHEREAS, the absence of such a safe, reliable and efficient truck creates a real and present emergency within the Ripley Utilities Department;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION 1. The Council of the Village of Ripley hereby declares the existence of a real and present emergency within the Ripley Utilities Department due to the lack of a safe, reliable and efficient truck.

SECTION 2. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to purchase the UTE 3165, 47' truck for use by the Ripley Utilities Department without competitive bidding at a price not to exceed \$155,075.00 pursuant to the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 735.051 or Section 735.052.


SECTION 3. The sum of UTE 3165, 47' truck as hereinabove set forth.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley and more particularly for the reason that it is necessary for the operation of the Ripley Utilities Department and Ripley Electric Department that the Village of Ripley have a safe, reliable and efficient truck for in the ordinary course of business of such departments and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
