VILLAGE OF RIPLEY OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 1305
EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPROVING
GARBAGE SERVICES BID AND AUTHORIZING CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley publicly advertised in accordance with applicable law for bids on a contract to collect garbage within the Village;

WHEREAS, the bid specifications set forth the terms and conditions of the proposals sought by the Village; and

WHEREAS, one bidder, Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. (“Rumpke”), has submitted two proposals, and no other proposals were submitted. Rumpke’s first proposal (Option A) provides in pertinent part for a fee of \$17.00 per residence per month for the duration of the five year contract, which amount includes one cart rental per residence. Rumpke’s second proposal (Option B) provides in pertinent part for a fee of \$15.50 per residence per month during the first year increasing by \$0.50 per year for the duration of the five year contract, with each residence paying an additional \$2.50 per month to rent a cart from Rumpke.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Ripley, State of Ohio, by a vote of majority of all members elected to the legislative authority:

SECTION 1: Rumpke’s Option A proposal is accepted.


SECTION 2: The Village Administrator is directed to work with legal counsel to negotiate a written contract with Rumpke including all of the material terms set forth in the bid specifications on the terms set forth in Rumpke’s Option A proposal and any additional terms deemed advisable by the Village Administrator and/or legal counsel.

SECTION 3: This is an emergency ordinance that is immediately effective and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety in the Village of Ripley, and for the further reason of obtaining implementing the Rumpke contract without delay thereby saving the Village amounts that will allow it to continue to provide vital services to the residents of the Village.
