ORDINANCE NO. 1314

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE DIRECTING VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADJUST
AND PRORATE GARBAGE COLLECTION FEES BASED ON DATE OF
COMMENCEMENT OF GARBAGE COLLECTION BY RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley publicly advertised in accordance with applicable law for bids on a contract to collect residential garbage within the Village;

WHEREAS, a contract for residential garbage collection has been awarded to Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. ("Rumpke") in accordance with Ohio law; and


WHEREAS, the commencement date of Rumpke's services will fall in the middle of a month such that the Village of Ripley will collect garbage for a portion of the month and Rumpke will collect garbage for a portion of the month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, State of Ohio, by a vote of at least a three-quarters majority of all members elected to the legislative authority:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator is hereby empowered and directed to take all reasonable and necessary steps to ensure that the amounts charged by the Village of Ripley for its garbage collection services and for Rumpke's garbage collection services are fairly and accurately adjusted and prorated to reflect the actual respective dates of service and to ensure that Village residents are properly and fairly billed for the services provided.

SECTION 2: This is an emergency ordinance that is immediately effective and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety in the Village of Ripley, and for the further reason to ensure that residents of the Village of Ripley are not subjected to any duplicative, excessive or inappropriate charges for garbage collection.
