

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 1319

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 1318, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE ISSUANCE OF LIMITED TAX GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$28,000 BY THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING TWO POLICE VEHICLES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, this Village Council adopted Ordinance No. 1318 on October 26, 2020 (the “Original Ordinance”), which authorized the issuance of limited tax general obligation bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$28,000, as further described in the Original Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, this Village Council has determined to amend certain provisions of the Original Ordinance, as provided herein;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Ohio (hereinafter called the “Municipality”):

**SECTION 1.** That the last sentence of Section 2 of the Original Ordinance shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Bonds shall be designated “Police Vehicle Acquisition Limited Tax General Obligation Bonds, Series 2021”.

**SECTION 2.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Village Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Village Council, and that all deliberations of this Village Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio and Section 12 of Am. Sub. H.B. 197 of the 133rd Ohio General Assembly, as amended by Section 1 of Sub. H.B. 404 of the 133rd Ohio General Assembly.

**SECTION 13.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the public peace, health, safety, morals or welfare require the amendment of the Original Ordinance to provide for the issuance of the Bonds for the purposes set forth in the Original Ordinance allow the citizens of the Municipality to enjoy the public safety benefits of the Project (as defined in the Original Ordinance) at the earliest possible time, and therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
