

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO
ORDINANCE # 1329

AN ORDINANCE REMOVING SHEILA DUFAU FROM VILLAGE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS, ADDING HEATHER HAUKE TO THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Ripley and Mayor recently accepted the resignation of Sheila Dufau as Village Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, Heather Hauke, was appointed as Interim Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, First State Bank requires that the former Fiscal Officer be formally removed from the Village of Ripley's First State Bank accounts by ordinance, and Heather Hauke be added to the financial accounts by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Ripley deems it proper and appropriate to approve an ordinance removing Sheila Dufau from the Village of Ripley's financial accounts with First State Bank and Heather Hauke be added to the financial accounts as required by the policy of First State Bank.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A MAJORITY OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Council hereby approves that Sheila Dufau be removed from the Village of Ripley financial accounts immediately and Heather Hauke be added to the financial accounts.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and its passage is immediately necessary to preserve, protect, and maintain health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Ripley, Ohio, to provide for a continuing Village official managing the Village's finances, and therefore, the same shall take effect and be in full force as the earliest period allowed by law.
