

VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO
ORDINANCE # 1338

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF VILLAGE COUNCIL TO APPOINT POLICE OFFICERS AND MANAGE CHIEF OF POLICE AND POLICE DEPARTMENT WHEN MAYOR UNAVAILABLE

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Ripley desires to set a policy allowing the President Pro Tempore of Council to appoint police officers and manage the affairs of the chief of police and police department in the event that the Mayor is unavailable; and

WHEREAS, The Council believes that setting forth a policy regarding the managing of the chief of police and police department when the Mayor is unavailable in the best interest of the Village of Ripley; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, BROWN COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A MAJORITY OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1: The Village Council hereby approves a new policy and procedure allowing the President Pro Tempore of Village Council to appoint police officers and manage the affairs of the chief of police and police department when the Mayor is unavailable.

SECTION 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force as the earliest period allowed by law.
