

**VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO**  
**ORDINANCE #1340**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EMPLOYMENT OF FULL-TIME POLICE  
OFFICER MICHAEL MYERS AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Council for the Village of Ripley, Ohio deems it necessary hire Michael Myers in the position of full-time police officer with the Village of Ripley Police Department by appointment of the Mayor and majority vote on May 25, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, Council deems it necessary and vital to operation of the Village of Ripley Police Department to hire Michael Myers as a full-time officer.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, STATE OF OHIO, WITH A MAJORITY OF ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** Michael Myers is hereby hired as a full-time police officer at a payrate pursuant to the Police Department Pay Schedule, with full time hours at the discretion of the Village Chief of Police.


**SECTION 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Ripley, Ohio to ensure that the Village has adequate police protection and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
